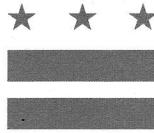

**Re: Installation of a Multi-way Stop Operation
Notice 13-05-TOA**

Dear Ms. Cook,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modification in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the intersection of Northampton Street and Utah Avenue, NW is controlled by Stop sign along Northampton Street. Utah Avenue is uncontrolled. An independent determination has been made by the Chief Traffic Signals, Safety, Standards and ITS of DDOT/Traffic Operations Administration (TOA) after reviewing the analysis report of this intersection that an All-Way stop condition is needed to address the concerns of the neighborhood for motorist, pedestrians and residents of this area. This new installation will include new "Stop" signs and "Advance Warning Stops Ahead" signs.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20003.
